

Access Information

Dexby Townhouse is a converted Victorian Townhouse and is not suitable for a lot of modifications including lifts.

We have a small step which leads to the front door, and all our rooms are located on the ground floor, first floor and 2nd floor.

The first two rooms are situated on the ground floor, but are not suitable for wheelchair access due to the width of the doors and a narrow corridor.

The next 3 rooms (2 kingsize ensuite and one twin ensuite) are located on the first floor, 13 steps to one of the rooms at the back of the house, and the other 2 are at a right angle and up a further 5 steps.

The 2 other rooms (one twin ensuite and one double ensuite) are located on the second floor, which are reached by a further 15 steps and we are happy to carry up your bags for you.

The dining room is on the ground floor but is accessed only by 13 steps from the ground floor to the first floor and then a further 13 steps down to the ground floor.

If you need assistance an intercom system is on the left hand side of the front door outside to contact the duty manager if needed.

We are happy to book taxis for you or assist with bus timetables.

Buses 25,32 and 60 leave the city centre to come up Cathedral Road and stop on the opposite side close to the guesthouse.

The City Centre is a 15 minute walk and we are happy to give directions to help.

Car parking is available on the road outside the Guest House with no restrictions or charges.
